◆ AHFS Consumer Medication Information is:

-- a trusted source and recognized standard for patient drug information, available in both English and Spanish. It includes more than a thousand drug information monographs written in lay language for consumers. Content is updated monthly.

◆ CINAHL Complete is

-- the world's most comprehensive source of full-text for nursing & allied health journals, providing full text for more than 1,300 journals indexed in *CINAHL*. This authoritative file contains full text for many of the most used journals in the *CINAHL* index, with no embargo. CINAHL® Complete is the definitive research tool for all areas of nursing & allied health literature.

◆ Cochrane Collection Plus is:

-- the most comprehensive collection of databases from the Cochrane Library, an essential source of high quality health care data for providers. It combines the **NHS Economic Evaluation Database (NHS EED)** (information on the costs and effects of drugs, treatments and procedures) and **Health Technology Assessments (HTA)** (provides details of completed and ongoing health technology assessments (studies of the medical, social, ethical and economic implications of healthcare interventions) from around the world) with the **Cochrane Database of Systematic Reviews (CDSR)** (contains full text articles, as well as protocols focusing on the effects of healthcare), **Database of Abstracts of Reviews of Effects (DARE)** (abstracts of published systematic reviews on the effects of health care from around the world), **Cochrane Central Register of Controlled Trials** (bibliography of controlled trials) and **Cochrane Methodology Register** (bibliography of publications reporting methods used in the conduct of controlled trials).

◆ **Health Source: Nursing/Academic Edition**

provides nearly 550 scholarly full text journals focusing on many medical disciplines. Health Source: Nursing/Academic Edition also features the Lexi-PAL Drug Guide, which covers 1,300 generic drug patient education sheets with more than 4,700 brand names.

◆ **Health Source: Consumer Edition**

consumer health information, providing information on many health topics including the medical sciences, food sciences and nutrition, childcare, sports medicine and general health. Provides access to nearly 80 full text, consumer health magazines.

◆ **MEDLINE®**

provides authoritative medical information on medicine, nursing, dentistry, veterinary medicine, the health care system, pre-clinical sciences, and much more. Created by the National Library of Medicine, MEDLINE uses MeSH (Medical Subject Headings) indexing with tree, tree hierarchy, subheadings and explosion capabilities to search citations from over 4,800 current biomedical journals.

◆ **Nursing Reference Center** is:

the premier evidence-based information resource designed specifically for nurses. With Nursing Reference Center, nurses can get answers to questions quickly, strengthen their nursing skills, and read full-text journal articles anytime, and anywhere.

◆ **Psychology and Behavioral Sciences Collection**

provides nearly 575 full text publications, covering topics such as emotional and behavioral characteristics, psychiatry & psychology, mental processes, anthropology, and observational and experimental methods. Updated daily.

◆ **Scientific & Medical ART (SMART) Imagebase**

enables you to download thousands of medical illustrations, videos, interactive tools, and monographs of anatomy, physiology, embryology, surgery, trauma, pathology, diseases, conditions and other topics. Search the database or browse by content, body systems/regions or medical specialties.
